A RESOLUTION 91-03

to authorize a political subdivision participating in the Tennessee Consolidated Retirement System to assume the employee's contributions in accordance with Title 8 section 34 through 37 of the Tennessee Code Annotated.

whereas, Public Chapter Number 508 Acts of 1981, permits a political subdivision to assume the employee's contributions; and

Whereas, effective July 1, 19 91, the Board of Commissioners (Name of Governing Body)

of the City of Belle Meade elects to assume and make its employee's (Name of Political Subdivision)

contributions to the retirement system of up to five percent (5%) of the employee's earnable compensation on behalf of all its employees in all departments; and

WHEREAS, the employee contributions paid by the employer shall be credited to the member's account provided the employee is a member of the Tennessee Consolidated Retirement System and employed by the participating political subdivision on the effective date specified above and that these contributions made on behalf of the member will be refunded to the member together with any contributions made by the member in the event the member terminates employment and makes application for a refund of contributions; and

WHEREAS, the political subdivision has the option to waive the established temporary period of employment for all employees who have not completed such period prior to July 1, 1991. The employee shall immediately become a member of the retirement system and be eligible for a refund of the employer assumed employee contributions upon termination of employment, and the employee's election not to receive a retirement allowance if such allowance is due; and

WHEREAS, should the employer elect to retain the established temporary period of employment for all employees who have not completed such period prior to July 1, 1991; said employee will be ineligible for a refund of the employer assumed employee contributions to the retirement system on the effective date of this Resolution. With full knowledge and understanding of the foregoing provision, the <a href="City of Belle Meade">City of Belle Meade</a> elects to <a href="waive">waive</a> (Waive/Retain)

the temporary period of employment for those employees affected by this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, for the purpose of computing the average final compensation for any member retiring from a participating political subdivision electing the provisions of the Public Chapter specified above, the annual salary for all years beginning with the effective date of the passage of this Resolution to the date of retirement or until July 1, 1991, whichever occurs first, will be increased by three and six tenths of one percent (3.6%);

WHEREAS, all liabilities resulting from this Resolution shall be the responsibility of the political subdivision and not the State of Tennessee; now therefore
