

RESOLUTION 2002-03

WHEREAS;

1. Section 15-301 of the Municipal Code of the City of Belle Meade provides in part that "it shall be unlawful for any person to operate or drive a motor vehicle upon any highway, street or public way in the City of Belle Meade at a rate of speed in excess of 30 miles per hour, except where official signs authorized by the Board of Commissioners have been posted indicating other speed limits . . .";

2. The Board of Commissioners have previously authorized a speed limit of 30 miles per hour for motor vehicles on West Tyne Drive and West Brookfield Avenue.

3. After careful consideration it has been determined that for the safety of the public the speed limit on West Tyne Drive and West Brookfield should be reduced to 25 miles per hour for motor vehicles.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Belle Meade, as follows:

Item 1. That the speed limit for all motor vehicles for West Tyne Drive and West Brookfield, be and the same hereby is reduced to 25 miles per hour.

Item 2. That appropriate signs be placed upon West Tyne Drive and West Brookfield Avenue showing these reduced speed limits.

Item 3. This resolution shall take effect 15 (fifteen) days after its passage, the public welfare of the City of Belle Meade requiring it.
