

ORDINANCE NO. 52-5

"AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO PAY THE ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF FURNISHING FIRE PROTECTION TO THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 52-3, ADOPTED ON THIRD READING ON JULY 15, 1952; AND AUTHORIZING DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS SO APPROPRIATED.

"BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Belle Meade as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars from the general funds of the City of Belle Meade for the purpose of paying the estimated annual cost of furnishing fire protection to the City of Belle Meade by a private fire department, the City Treasurer having certified that such funds are on hand in the treasury or will be on hand in time to meet such obligation.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Manager are hereby expressly authorized to disburse such funds over a period of one year from the date of first passage of this ordinance, in such manner and in such amounts as may be provided by contract between the City of Belle Meade and the person or company furnishing such services.

SECTION 3. Any funds hereby appropriated in excess of the actual disbursements made pursuant to contract for services for fire protection shall revert to the general funds of the City.
