## ORDINANCE NO. 81-3

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 80-1, "AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE FUNCTIONS OF THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE, TENNESSEE, INCLUDING SALARIES OF ALL EMPLOYEES AND PAYMENTS RELATED THERETO, PURCHASES OF SUPPLIES, MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT, PAYMENT FOR SERVICES RENDERED PURSUANT TO CONTRACTS, UTILITY SERVICES, AND ALL OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1980-1981; AND PROVIDING FOR REVERSION OF ALL UNDISBURSED FUNDS HEREBY APPROPRIATED."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS FOLLOWS:

That Section 1 and 2 of Ordinance 80-1 be repealed and replaced by the following:

SECTION 1. There are hereby appropriated by the City of Belle Meade the following amounts of money, out of funds already in the Treasury of the City or reasonably anticipated to be on hand when payments therefrom shall be required:
