

ORDINANCE 86-4

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 11-101 OF THE BELLE MEADE CITY CODE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING A MUNICIPAL PLANNING COMMISSION

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Belle Meade, as follows:

Section 1. The text of Belle Meade City Code, Section 11-101, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"There is created and established a municipal planning commission, the same to be known as the municipal planning commission of the City of Belle Meade. Such planning commission shall consist of ten members, and one of the said ten members shall be the city manager of the City of Belle Meade and another of the said ten members shall be a commissioner chosen by the board of commissioners. The other eight members shall be appointed by the city manager, who shall make his appointment in writing and shall file said written appointment with the city recorder. The terms of the members of the municipal planning commission of the City of Belle Meade shall be as follows: the terms of the city manager and the city commissioner elected to the planning commission shall be concurrent with the term of such commission member on the board of commissioners. The eight members initially appointed by the city manager shall serve until the end of the particular terms established by prior ordinances to which they are appointed hereunder, and upon expiration of these terms, the city manager shall appoint their successors, each of whom shall serve a term of three years so that the terms of two or three members of said commission shall expire each year. Any vacancy in any appointed membership shall be filled for the unexpired term by the city manager, who shall also have authority to remove any appointed member at this pleasure, or accept the resignation of any such appointment member. The board of commissioners shall elect the

successor to the commissioner members elected by it, such successor likewise to be a commissioner of the city. The board of commissioners shall also have authority to accept his resignation".

Section 2. This Ordinance becomes effective upon its passage.
