

RESOLUTION 87-08

WHEREAS as it has come to the attention of the Commissioners of the City of Belle Meade that in the interest of safety on the streets of Belle Meade, the following be adopted:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Four way stop at Tyne and Westview be established with appropriate signs.

2. Three-way stop at Jackson Boulevard and Gerald Place be established with appropriate signs.

3. That the speed limit on Chickering Lane, from the city limits to Chickering Road, and Chickering Road, from the city limits to Belle Meade Boulevard, be thirty (30) M.P.H. and that the appropriate signs be installed. Additionally, on Chickering Lane just inside the city limits, a sign reading "slow, curve" be installed.

4. That at the intersection of Clarendon and Evelyn Avenue be made one way in the direction of Clarendon Avenue right onto Evelyn and the direction on Evelyn Avenue curving right onto Clarendon.
