RESOLUTION 94-06

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A "CHILDREN'S BRIDGE" PROJECT, UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE, AS FOLLOWS:

The Children's Bridge Project as outlined in the attached letter of August 5, 1994, from Nancy Schon, the Boston sculptor, whom the Children's Bridge Committee selected for the project, is hereby approved, subject to the following stipulations,

The City recognizes that the Children's Bridge Committee was comprised of the following people:

Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Ledbetter

Mrs. Ann Eisenstein

Mr. and Mrs. Edward Nelson

Mrs. Alex Pirtle

Mrs. Elizabeth Proctor

The City understands that the Committee unanimously approved Mrs. Schon's proposal. It further recognizes that the completion of this project will be in approximately one year. Mr. Ledbetter is solely responsible for the approximate seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000.00) needed to fund the project, and the city shall incur no expense in connection with the project which cannot be funded from contributions already paid into the segregated account hereinafter referred to. The City recognizes that Mr. Ledbetter has sent Mrs. Schon a personal check in the amount of nineteen thousand dollars (\$19,000.00), so she can begin work on the statues. Mr. Ledbetter expects the first fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000.00) raised to be remitted to him as he wishes his direct contribution to be five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00).

In his fund-raising efforts, Mr. Ledbetter will ask that all donations be tax deductible payments made to the City of Belle Meade earmarked for the Children's Bridge project. The City agrees to segregate the funds raised by Mr. Ledbetter and to make the appropriate payments as they become due. Landscaping of the site will be provided by the City from Ceres Society funds, and advice from the Committee will be sought as to the nature and character of such landscapings.

The City of Belle Meade is appreciative of the contribution of Nancy Schon, of Boston, and is pleased to have her involvement in the project, the only such statues ever contemplated on Belle Meade Boulevard.
