

RESOLUTION 2001-06

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE SECONDARY EMPLOYMENT POLICY OF THE CITY
OF BELLE MEADE

WHEREAS;

1. By Resolution 2000-01 the Commissioners of the City of Belle Meade adopted a Secondary Employment Policy, which provides in part that Secondary Employment assignments constituting a part of the official duties of the City "shall be performed exclusively within the city limits of the City of Belle Meade".

2. Tennessee Code Annotated § 6-54-301 provides in part that the "police authority of all incorporated towns and cities shall extend to a distance of one (1) mile from the lawful corporate limits thereof for the suppression of all disorderly acts and practices forbidden by the general laws of the state".

3. The Commissioners desire to conform the jurisdictional limits of the Secondary Employment Policy with the foregoing provisions of the statute


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Belle Meade, as follows:

Item 1. Paragraph 6 of the Section of the Secondary Employment Policy of the City of Belle Meade entitled "SPECIAL RULES RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT BY THE BMPD" is amended to read as follows:

"6. All BMPD Secondary Employment assignments shall be performed within a distance of one (1) mile from the corporate limits of the City of Belle Meade, for the suppression of all disorderly acts and practices forbidden by the general laws of the State of Tennessee; provided that such jurisdiction shall not be extended so as to come within one (1) mile of any other incorporated town or city."
