## ORDINANCE NO. 83-7

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A USER CHARGE SYSTEM FOR USERS OF THE WASTEWATER COLLECTION FACILITIES OF THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. There is hereby adopted a user charge system for users of the wastewater collection facilities of the City of Belle Meade.
- 2. The user charges are developed on the basis that all customers are considered residential, and there will be a standard user charge per volume of water consumed, adjusted so as to take into account water not normally entering the sewerage system (e.g., used to fill swimming pools, for sprinkling lawns, etc.) in like manner as adjustments are made by the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, Tennessee, in the calculation of its sewer user charges to its customers.
- 3. User charges must generate sufficient revenue to pay for the cost of operation and maintenance of the facilities, including the cost of equipment replacement. Charges will be reviewed at or prior to the end of the first year of operation of the system and at least annually thereafter, and revised as may be required. Such charges and any revisions will be provided for by separate Resolution of the Belle Meade City Commissioners, pursuant to Section 13-06, Belle Meade Municipal Code.
- 4. Quantity discounts to large volume users will not be made.
- 5. The Belle Meade wastewater facilities will not accept wastewater from treatment works owned by others.
- 6. The monthly water and sewer bill for each customer will list separately the amounts due for water service, sewerage service, and for the user charge.
- 7. This ordinance is to be construed and applied along with Belle Meade Code, Section 13-101, et seq., is supplementary thereto, and shall not be construed as in conflict therewith.

8. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of the City of Belle Meade requiring it.
