

ORDINANCE 87-6

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION
1-402 OF THE BELLE MEADE CITY CODE
PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENT OF CITY
JUDGE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Belle Meade, as follows:

Section 1. The text of Belle Meade City Code, Section
1-402, is hereby amended to read as follows:

The City Court shall be presided over by a City judge,
who shall be appointed by and whose compensation shall
be set by the board of commissioners. In case of absence
or disability of the city judge, the mayor shall designate
a special judge to act in the place and stead of the
city judge, with all powers incident to that office.

Section 2. This ordinance becomes effective upon its
passage.
