ORDINANCE 88-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 11-208
OF THE BELLE MEADE MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROVIDE
REFERENCE TO REQUIREMENTS OF THE TENNESSEE
WATER QUALITY ACT

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Belle Meade, as follows:

Section 1. Belle Meade Code, Section 11-208, is amended by renumbering Sections (2) and (3) as Section (3) and (4) and by adding the following as Section (2):

"In accordance with the Tennessee Water Quality
Act, T.C.A. 69-3-108, any activity which alters the
course or physical character of a stream, defined
by a blue line on a 7½ minute U.S.G.S quadrangle,
requires an Aquatic Resource Alteration Permit (ARAP).
This permit is required for activities such as stream
channelization, stream enlargement, dredging, or
diversions in box culverts. To obtain the permit,
application must be made to Tennessee Division of
Water Polution Control.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
