

ORDINANCE 88-6

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BELLE MEADE CODE, SECTION 4-103, DEALING WITH REQUIREMENTS FOR HAND RAILS AND GUARD RAILS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE, as follows:

Section 1. Section 4-103 of the Belle Meade Code is hereby amended by changing section R-215.1 to read as follows:

"R-215.1 - Hand rails. Hand rails having minimum and maximum heights of thirty (30) inches and thirty four (34) inches, respectively, measuring vertically from the nosing of the treads shall be provided on at least one side of stairways of four (4) or more risers, including exterior steps or stairways. Open sides of such stairs with a total rise of more than thirty (30) inches above the floor or grade below shall have guard rails.

Section 2. This Ordinance becomes effective upon passage.
