

ORDINANCE 88-7

AN ORDINANCE ADDING CHAPTER 4 TO TITLE 13 OF THE BELLE MEADE CODE, PROHIBITING PLACEMENT ABOVE GROUND OF TELEPHONE, TELEGRAPH, CABLE TELEVISION, ELECTRIC, OR OTHER UTILITY LINES, UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Belle Meade, as follows:

Section 1. Title 13 of the Belle Meade Code is hereby amended by adding Chapter 4 thereto, Section 1 of which shall read as follows:

"13-401. No telephone, telegraph, cable television, electric, or other utility line on any public street, road, or other right-of-way of the City of Belle Meade, may be placed above ground without consent of the City of Belle Meade as expressed in a Resolution by its Board of Commissioners, where such line now is or in the future may have been placed underground."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect on the date of final passage, but not earlier than fifteen days after passage on first reading.
