

ORDINANCE 2002-9

AN ORDINANCE ELECTING TO OPT OUT OF
THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 4 AND 6 OF CHAPTER 862 OF
THE PUBLIC ACTS OF TENNESSEE FOR THE YEAR 2002


WHEREAS:

1. Chapter 862 of the Public Acts of Tennessee for the year 2002 (the "Act") requires, among other things, that municipalities offer training and continuing education to various municipal officials, including, among others, all planning commission members, board of zoning appeals members and other administrative officials whose duties include advising a planning commission or board of zoning appeals;
2. Subsection 4(9) and Subsection 6(9) of the Act authorize the legislative body in a municipality, which is subject to the Act, to opt out of its provisions by passage of an ordinance;
3. The Commissioners of the City of Belle Meade deem it in the best interest of the City to opt out of the provisions of the Act at this time;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS
FOLLOWS:


1. The City of Belle Meade elects to opt out of the provisions of Sections 4 and 6 of Chapter 862 of the Public Acts of Tennessee for the year 2002.
2. This Ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after its passage.
