

## ORDINANCE 2003-2

An Ordinance Amending Chapter Two, Title 14 of the Belle Meade Code To Change the Classification of certain Property Fronting on Belle Meade Boulevard from Residence A to Residence B

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have been asked to consider an amendment to Chapter Two, Title 14, of the Belle Meade Code (the Belle Meade Zoning Ordinance) reclassifying from Residence A to Residence B Lots Nos. 820, 824 and 828 Belle Meade Boulevard (the same being Map 130-6; Parcels 65, 70 and 71), Collectively, the "Property", and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has recommended the proposed reclassification of the Property, together with certain other property, omitted by amendment from this ordinance, and this matter has been duly considered by the Commissioners at a Public hearing, as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the property is located adjacent to other property that is already classified Residence B and the Commissioners are satisfied that the proposed reclassification is in the best interests of the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE, as follows:

## ITEM 1


The Zoning classification of the Property is hereby changed from Residence A to Residence B.
