

ORDINANCE NO. 72-7

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PURCHASE BY THE CITY OF GASOLINE FOR USE IN ITS MOTOR VEHICLES IN QUANTITIES SUFFICIENT, AND FOR THE STORAGE AND USE OF SUCH GASOLINE UNDER CONDITIONS SO AS TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF TENNESSEE LAW ALLOWING EXEMPTION OF CERTAIN TAXES IMPOSED UPON THE PURCHASE OF GASOLINE; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE INSTALLATION OF ONE OR MORE STORAGE TANKS UPON PROPERTY OF THE CITY, AND OTHER PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR THE APPROVAL OF SAID AGREEMENT BY RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE as follows:

SECTION 1. The City of Belle Meade shall take action by agreement, to be negotiated by the Mayor and City Manager, to cause to be installed upon property of the City, readily accessible to the Police Department and other officials of the City of Belle Meade, one or more storage tanks, of such capacity, design and material as to comply with the requirements of the State of Tennessee allowing the purchase and storage and use of gasoline by the City in its motor vehicles without payment of certain taxes to the said State, as is provided in Tennessee Code Annotated, Sections 67-3701,-3706. Said agreement shall also provide for compliance with all laws, rules and regulations in the interest of safety applicable to such installation and use.

SECTION 2. The Board of Commissioners shall review and approve by resolution any contract providing for the installation and storage of gasoline and activities related thereto, before said agreement shall be effective.

SECTION 3. The City Manager shall, with the assistance of the Chief of Police of the City of Belle Meade, establish and follow a system for accounting for the purchase, storage and use in motor vehicles owned and operated by the City, and for City purposes only, of gasoline, and shall maintain all records required by the State or other governmental bodies in current status and available for inspection by State officials, and by the Board of Commissioners and other authorized persons.

SECTION 4. The City Manager is expressly authorized to purchase gasoline in such quantities as will comply with the minimum requirements of the State law aforesaid, provided no purchase order shall amount to as much as One Thousand (\$1,000) Dollars and further provided such purchase shall be made with funds appropriated therefor by ordinance.
