

PROPOSED ORDINANCE #73-3

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS PROVIDED BY U. S. TREASURY DEPARTMENT DESIGNATED AS "REVENUE SHARING" FOR USE IN THE PURCHASE OF AUTOMOBILES TO BE USED IN A PROGRAM OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND SPECIFICALLY FOR THE PURCHASE OF POLICE PATROL VEHICLES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The sum of \$5,550.00, received from the U. S. Treasury Department between the dates January 1 and June 30, 1973, is hereby appropriated for use by the City in paying for the purchase of new police patrol automobiles to be used in patrolling the roads and streets of the City of Belle Meade, in order to promote safe driving by enforcing the traffic laws, and to promote the safety of persons on the less traveled frequented streets by frequent patrolling of of same.

The funds so received will be added to those provided in the budget for 1973 designated Account (H)(2) - Police Department Maintenance and Repairs - \$6,700.00. Any excess remaining in said account as of the end of the fiscal year will revert to the general fund of the City and be subject to further appropriations.


