

ORDINANCE 84-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 11-206 OF THE BELLE MEADE CITY CODE, ESTABLISHING A BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Belle Meade, as follows:

Section 1. Belle Meade City Code, Section 11-206, is amended as follows:

(a) By deleting the first paragraph in its entirety and substituting in lieu thereof,

"There is hereby created an administrative board of five (5) members, to be known as the Board of Zoning Appeals, which shall have full power and authority to hear appeals and to apply and construe the provisions of this chapter in all matters properly brought before it. The Chairman and Members of this Board shall be appointed by the Mayor, who shall make the appointments in writing and shall file such written appointments with the City Recorder. Of the five members initially appointed, one shall serve for a term of one year, two for a term of two years, and two for a term of three years. At the expiration of the terms of initial appointment, all re-appointments or new appointments shall be for a term of three years. Any vacancy shall be filled for the un-expired term by the Mayor, who shall also have the authority to remove any appointed member at his/her pleasure, or to accept the resignation of any such appointed member."

(b) By substituting "three (3)" for "five (5)" in the second line of the third paragraph.

(c) This Ordinance becomes effective upon its passage.
