

ORDINANCE 84-6

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9-110
OF THE BELLE MEADE CITY CODE GOVERNING
VEHICULAR TRAFFIC ON BELLE MEADE BOULE-
VARD AND OTHER BELLE MEADE STREETS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 9-110 of the Belle Meade City Code is hereby amended by changing the second paragraph thereof to read as follows:

On two (2) and three (3) lane streets, the proper lane for travel shall be the right-hand lane unless otherwise clearly marked. On streets with four (4) or more lanes, except for Belle Meade Boulevard, either of the right-hand lanes shall be available for use except that traffic moving at less than the normal rate of speed shall use the extreme right-hand lane. On Belle Meade Boulevard, the proper lane for travel shall be the extreme right-hand lane, and it shall be unlawful to use the lane nearer the median except when lawfully passing another vehicle or when preparing for a left turn.
