

ORDINANCE 89-7

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 1, OF THE BELLE MEADE CODE, TO PROHIBIT CREATION OF "THROUGH" STREETS

WHEREAS, The area within the City of Belle Meade is now substantially developed and is adequately served by through streets as hereinafter defined,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Belle Meade, as follows:

Section 1. That Title 11, Chapter 1, of the Belle Meade Code be amended to add a Section 11-110, to read as follows:

11-110. (a) Definitions. "Through street".

A through street is a street which connects with more than one other street, unless such other street is a tributary of the first and does not itself connect with any other street.

(b) From and after the effective date of this ordinance no through streets shall be created within the City of Belle Meade.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon the passage thereof.
