ORDINANCE 90-11

AN ORDINANCE TO CLOSE, VACATE AND ABANDON THE REMAINING PORTION OF A CERTAIN STREET OR RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE KNOWN AS DUPONT AVENUE, BUT RETAINING EASEMENTS IN SAME FOR FUTURE USE BY PUBLIC UTILITIES.

WHEREAS, there is shown on the major street plan of the City of Belle Meade, heretofore filed in the Register's Office for Davidson County, Tennessee, of record in Book 1130, Page 9, a certain dedicated but unimproved and unopened right-of-way, designated thereon as DuPont Avenue; and

WHEREAS, portions of this right-of-way have been closed, vacated and abandoned by previous ordinances of the City of Belle Meade, and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Planning Commission at its meeting held on November 20, 1990, recommended the closing of the remaining portion of said right-of-way,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Belle Meade, as follows:

Section 1. That DuPont Avenue shown on the major street plan of the City of Belle Meade, of record in Book 1130, page 9, Registers Office for Davidson County, Tennessee, and described as follows, is hereby closed, vacated and abandoned;

BEGINNING at the north margin of Lynwood Lane and running northwardly to a line connecting the point at which the west margin of DuPont intersects the south margin of Webster Lane with the point at which the east margin of DuPont intersects the north margin of Webster Lane.

Section 2. Be it further ordained that any and all public utility or other easements in said right-of-way now held by the City of Belle Meade, or others, shall not be terminated or in any way restricted or diminished by the passage of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
