

ORDINANCE 91-5

AN ORDINANCE TO CLOSE, VACATE AND ABANDON A PORTION OF A CERTAIN STREET OR RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE KNOWN AS SHEPARD PLACE, BUT RETAINING EASEMENTS IN SAME FOR FUTURE USE BY PUBLIC UTILITIES

WHEREAS, there is shown on the major street plan of the City of Belle Meade, heretofore filed in the Register's Office for Davidson County, Tennessee, of record in Book 1130, Page 9, a certain street or right-of-way designated as Shepard Place; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Planning Commission at its meeting held on August 20, 1991, recommended the closing of a portion of said street or right-of-way,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Belle Meade, as follows:


Section 1. The below described portion of Shepard Place, a street or right-of-way shown on the major street plan of the City of Belle Meade of record in Book 1130, Page 9, Registers Office for Davidson County, Tennessee, is hereby closed, vacated and abandoned:

BEGINNING at the north east corner and running westwardly for a distance of 60' feet along the north side of said right-of-way; thence, southerly at right angle to the south side of said right-of-way; thence, easterly along said right-of-way to the end of said right-of-way; thence, northwardly along the eastern end of said right-of-way to closure with said starting point.

Section 2. Be if further ordained that any and all public utility or other easements in said right-of-way now held by the City of Belle Meade, or others, shall not be terminated or in any way restricted or diminished by the passage of this ordinance.


Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
