## Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by James Hunt, Mayor, at 8:20 am.

1. Appointment to Board of Building Code Appeals - Gray Thornburg

This position will replace Boyd Bogle's seat on the BBCA for November 2018 only.

Motion to approve: Weigel Second: Wilson Vote: All aye

2. Consideration of Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Metro Nashville, regarding street maintenance

This amendment affects the cities of Oak Hill, Forest Hills and Belle Meade, whose residents pay Metro Nashville/Davidson County property taxes. It acknowledges that these three satellite cities in Davidson County provide and pay for the maintenance of roadways and associated infrastructure within their jurisdictions, with no financial assistance from Metro Government. The MOU will be amended to provide for "Roadway Cost Payments" annually from Metro Government beginning August 1, 2019. The term of this agreement shall be for 15 years, with options to extend. The payments to Belle Meade for the first 3 years are as follows, with the remaining years to be increased/decreased according to the CPI of All Urban Consumers: 2019 - \$193,617.00; 2020 - \$253,191.00; 2021 - \$297,872.00

3. Consideration of Traffic Control solutions on Jackson Blvd. (delineators, etc.)

Delineators are creating more traffic problems with pedestrians. Cars and trucks do not have room to go around pedestrians and avoid hitting the delineators. Wilson suggested replacing delineator with "Walking District" signage. A motion was made to remove the delineators now and continue to research traffic calming solutions.

4. Consideration of hiring off-duty police officers for patrol on Jackson Blvd. during Hillwood Bridge construction period.

Discussion to hire one part time officer for 4 hour shifts, 5 days a week for up to 9 months or the duration of the bridge construction.

Motion to approve: Weigel Second: None Motion dies for lack of Second

Discussion continued regarding the installation of temporary speed tables on both lanes of the street as recommended by the Collier Engineering study for a trial period lasting for the duration of the Hillwood Bridge construction. In addition, officers should increase traffic control duties in all areas of Belle Meade.

Motion to approve: Altenbern Second: Thornburg

Vote: Aye: Hunt, Altenbern, Thornburg Opposed: Weigel and Wilson

5. First Tennessee Bank Resolution of Company for Visa business credit card Application

Truxton Trust doesn't offer a Visa card and the Truxton Mastercard has had repeated issues with fraud.
