### HISTORIC ZONING COMMISSION HOLDS INAUGURAL MEETING – JANUARY 14, 2020



After more than 4 months of workshops and planning meetings to create the rules and procedures of the Commission, draft the ordinance to create a conservation overlay, and then work with a consultant to draft the Interim Design Guidelines, the HZC

heard its first appeals in January. Throughout the course of this first year, the Commission will continue to refine the Design Guidelines in preparation for adoption of Final Guidelines.

The City has applied for a federal grant through the Tennessee Historical Commission which will help to fund the cost of consultant services to achieve this goal.

I am excited to announce that the Belle Meade Police Department will be offering an 8-hour RoadWise Driver™ course for Seniors three times during the 2020 year. This AAA Course will allow students an opportunity to receive a discount on their vehicle insurance in most cases. Please check with your insurance agent to see if you are eligible, since age restrictions differ between insurance companies. If you are eligible, I encourage you to sign up and take the course. The course will be split over two days with each session lasting 4 hours or less. The first class will be held March 25th & 26th beginning at 5:30 p.m. Future dates will be announced. The Course is free to Belle Meade residents. Eventually we will offer courses to non-residents. 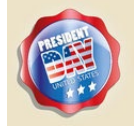
