Date	Incident	Address	Description
3-23-2020	LPR/Stolen Vehicle	Harding Rd & Lynwood Blvd	LPR hit on a stolen vehicle. The vehicle was stopped and the driver was arrested.
3-23-2020	Officer Investigation	Abbott Martin & Walnut Dr	Received a call complaining of a vehicle parked on the road blocking traffic. It was construction workers and they moved the vehicle into the driveway.
3-24-2020	Officer Investigation	500 Block of Westview Ave	Assisted the fire department with a possible house fire. Upon arrival, it was determined that lightening hit the garage but there was no fire just smoke from the electrical outlets
