Date	Incident	Address	Description
7-20-2020	911 Hang-up	300 Block of Lynwood Blvd	We received a 911 hang-up call which turned out to be an accidental dial by one of the construction workers.
7-21-2020	Safety Hazard	1300 Block of Page Rd	Tree down in the road. Parke Company cleared it.
7-21-2020	Safety Hazard	1200 Canterbury Drive	We found tree limbs in the road. We were able to clear them and notified Public Works to clean up the rest the next day.
7-21-2020	Suspicious Vehicle	100 Block of Bellevue Drive South	We received a call about a vehicle in the area the caller didn't recognize. It turned out to be a house cleaner who had been given the wrong address.
7-21-2020	Assist Citizen	4300 Block of Tyne Blvd	We assisted a driver whose vehicle had a flat tire. We got them off of the road and they wanted to wait for their own wrecker.
7-21-2020	Officer Investigation	Manor Drive	We responded to a complaint of a solicitor who was warned of the ordinance and sent on his way.
7-21-2020	Assist Other Agency	Walnut Ave	We responded to assist the Nashville Fire Department. It turned out to be a medical issue.
7-22-2020	Assist Other Agency	Harding Place	We assisted SkyCop with traffic control while they worked on the cameras.
7-22-2020	Safety Hazard	1200 Block of Chickering Rd	We assisted public works with a tree in the road.
7-22-2020	Assist Citizen	Harding Rd & Davidson Rd	We assisted a broken down motorist. The officer stayed with the vehicle which was blocking a lane of traffic until a tow truck arrived.
7-22-2020	Assist Citizen	Glen Eden Dr & Jackson Blvd	Officer found a vehicle parked in a lane of traffic. The vehicle was parked and the driver was assisting a deer that was stuck in a wrought iron fence. The officer assisted the baby doe by bending the fence and pushing the deer through the rest of the way. the deer suffered a couple of scrapes from the fence.

7-25-2020	Assist Citizen	Harding Rd	We received a call about a male subject walking in the roadway. We checked on him and he was crossing the road to walk on the other side of the road. One of the officers gave him a ride to Bellevue.

We made contact and it was an older gentleman who was out riding his bike when it started to rain. He was standing on their porch to try and stay dry. He was asked to leave by the home owner.

7-25-2020	Officer Investigation	Chickering Lane	We received a call of a noise complaint We checked the area but did not hear anything and did not receive any other calls on it.

The outer garage door was closed and there was no signs of forced entry. Apparently, they had forgotten to close the door when they left.
