| 8-17-2020 | Assist Citizen        | Lynwood Blvd                  | An officer was flagged down by a pedestrian and was given a dog that was found. The officer took the dog to the vet who scanned for a chip but one was not found. The Belle Meade Animal Hospital offered to house the dog until the owner was located. It was posted on Nextdoor and the Mayor sent out a Neighborhood Watch notice. |
| 8-17-2020 | Officer Investigation | Harding Rd.& Belle Meade Blvd | An officer attempted to stop a speeding vehicle. The driver took off the wrong way on Belle Meade Blvd at an extreme rate of speed. Due to the danger, there was no pursuit. Another officer tried to stop them at Belle Meade Blvd and Harding Pl, but they failed to stop again. They were last seen turning onto Chickering Rd.    |
| 8-17-2020 | Suspicious Person     | 5000 Block of Harding Rd      | We received a call about a homeless male subject looking for assistance. He was asked to leave the city.  |
| 8-17-2020 | Traffic Stop          | Belle Meade Blvd & Malone Pl  | We made a traffic stop with a driver whose license were suspended. A misdemeanor citation was issued.   |
| 8-18-2020 | Theft                 | 4400 Block of Honeywood Dr    | We took a Theft from a Motor Vehicle report from a resident whose wallet was stolen from her vehicle while she was parked at the Belle Meade Country Club.  |

| 8-21-2020 | Officer Investigation | Carriage Hill                 | Metro Nashville PD called about a potential homicide/armed barricaded subject situation. Metro and our units responded to find the residents fine. Metro later ruled the original call to be a prank. |
| 8-21-2020 | Officer Investigation | Belle Meade Blvd              | We received a complaint of a vehicle driving recklessly. We were unable to locate the vehicle.  |

| 8-22-2020 | Suspicious Person     | 800 Block of Belle Meade Blvd | We received a report of a male subject looking into vehicles parked in the overflow parking lot. We were on scene at time of dispatch and could not locate the subject.                               |
