Date	Incident	Address	Description
8-31-2020	LPR/Stolen Tag	Lynwood Blvd & Abbott Martin	We received a LPR hit on a stolen tag that had been recovered but the entering agency had failed to remove it from NCIC. The driver was arrested because of an active warrant and handed over to Williamson County Sheriff's Office.
8-31-2020	Assist Citizen	Belle Meade Blvd	We cleared up a traffic jam caused by kindergarten traffic and a tree crew that was blocking one lane.
8-31-2020	Officer Investigation	300 Block of Belle Meade Blvd	We received a call from a resident who noticed a light on in his neighbor's apartment that he did not think was on earlier in the day. The neighbor is out of town and the caller had a key to the apartment, so we did a walk through and nothing appeared to have been disturbed

9-02-2020	Assist Other Agency	200 Block of Deer Park Dr	Assisted Vanderbilt Police Department with a suspicious person on their property. The subject was seen on their camera at the rear of the property walking a dog. We searched the area but did not locate the subject.
9-02-2020	Officer Investigation	Harding Rd & Davidson Rd	We completed a damage to city property report for a damaged street sign. Metro arrested the responsible party for DUI.

9-06-2020	Officer Investigation	4400 Howell Pl	A resident called to report someone tapping on her window in the middle of the night. We did not find anyone or any evidence that anyone had been there.
9-06-2020	Officer Investigation	400 Ellendale	Someone called to report their car alarm had gone off. We did not find anyone or any evidence that someone had opened the vehicle door. The caller advised that he had locked the vehicle after the alarm had gone off and before we arrived.
