Date	Incident	Address	Description
9-08-2020	LPR/Stolen Vehicle	Lynwood Blvd & Glen Eden	We received a LPR hit on a stolen vehicle but we were unable to locate the vehicle.
9-08-2020	Assist Other Agency	Belle Meade Blvd & Page Rd	We assisted Metro Park Police in locating an injured cyclist in Percy Warner Park. We found him and advised the ambulance the route to get to him.
9-09-2020	Officer Investigation	700 Block of Lynwood Blvd	We received a call of construction work going on after hours. We made contact with the workers and informed them of the city ordinance. They packed everything up and finished for the day and the contractor was also informed of that by the homeowner.
