Date	Incident	Address	Description
10-12-2020	Suspicious Vehicle	1300 Block of Chickering Rd	We checked on a vehicle that had stopped in a vacant lot for an emergency bathroom break.
10-12-2020	Officer Investigation	Harding Place	We received 2 calls of a woman walking through the area yelling at passing cars. She advised that she was in the process of walking home so we gave her a ride to Bellevue.
10-12-2020	Officer Investigation	Westview Ave & Forsythe Pl	We received a call of a pickup truck occupied by three juveniles driving recklessly up and down the street. We checked the area but made no contact.
10-12-2020	Assist Citizen	Belle Meade Blvd & Page Rd	We assisted a broken down motorist.
10-12-2020	Safety Hazard	Belle Meade Blvd	We received a call of a motorist traveling north bound in the south bound lanes of the boulevard. We checked the area but was unable to locate the vehicle.
10-13-2020	Assist Citizen	700 Westview Ave	We responded to a snake that was stuck in some netting. We got the snake cut loose enough to get into a box and the resident took it to a vet.
10-14-2020	Suspicious Vehicle	Tyne Blvd & Lynwood Blvd	We received a call about a black vehicle parked on the shoulder of the road. We checked the area and the vehicle was no longer there.
10-14-2020	Assist Other Agency	Page Rd	Metro requested assistance with a crash with injuries. It turned out to be a single car crash and the driver refused medical attention.
10-15-2020	Assist Citizen	Harding Rd & Lynwood Blvd	Officer drove up on a broken down vehicle blocking traffic and no driver around. When the driver returned he stated he had ran out of gas. It turned out that the driver had a revoked drivers' license and two warrants but the agencies would not extradite him. The driver was issued a misdemeanor citation and the vehicle was towed.

10-15-2020	Officer Investigation	600 Block of Westview Ave	We responded to a 911 hang-up that Metro asked us to check on. We talked to everyone at the home and no one had called and did not know the number the call came from.
10-15-2020	Assist Citizen	Chickering Rd & Chickering Lane	We received a call about a dumpster in the middle of the road. It was not there when the officer arrived.
10-16-2020	Assist Citizen	5300 Block of Harding Rd	We assisted a citizen that locked her keys in her car.
10-16-2020	Assist Citizen	4700 Block of Harding Rd	We assisted with traffic control at City Hall for early voting.
10-17-2020	Suspicious Incident	1300 Block of Chickering Rd	We responded to a call from a house sitter about strange noises coming from the basement. She asked that we come out and walk through the house to make sure everything was okay. We checked the house and found that the sound was possibly coming from one of the tankless water heater systems. She was going to contact the homeowner to have someone to come out and service it.
10-17-2020	Suspicious Incident	1300 Block of Chickering Rd	We received a call from a resident stating that he thought he heard his doorbell ring and then someone possibly knocking on his door. He asked that we come check the location due to how late it was. We walked around the home and all doors were locked and no signs that anyone had been there.
10-17-2020	Assist Other Agency	Page Rd & Brookfield	We assisted Metro with a call about a cyclist being struck by a car. When we arrived, the cyclist explained that he had crashed his bike and the motorist on scene was trying to help him. He had not been struck by a vehicle and refused medical treatment.
