Haley moved to Belle Meade when she was five years old and has been a resident ever since. She is a graduate of Harpeth Hall School and the University of Alabama, where she majored in Psychology and Early Childhood Development. In 2017, she decided to focus her efforts solely on her passion for education

Her work at the Charter School Center focuses on the creation of schools that will serve as pockets of innovation in large school systems where new teaching strategies and educational theories can be used without some of the limitations placed on traditional public schools in order to give parents choice within the public school system. Haley believes very strongly that a thriving business community depends largely on the strength of our public schools and she works tirelessly to pave the way for new successes.

She is keenly aware of the unique position cities like Belle Meade are in as Nashville continues to grow at breakneck speed. Land preservation, beautification, and historic architecture are particular interests of Haley's, and she is also well versed in her knowledge of stormwater issues, building codes, even short term rental policies. Her hands-on experience at the legislature has made her keenly aware of how both state and local governments must work together to create an environment where cities like Belle Meade can thrive and flourish. Haley has served as a member of the Board of Zoning Appeals for the city of Belle Meade since 2019, is a former member of the Kindergarten Advisory Board of St. George's Church, and has served as the Vice President of Policy for Julia Green Elementary School for 11 years.
