11-02-2020	Assist Citizen	400 Block of Shepard Pl	We assisted a resident that had fallen.
11-02-2020	Officer Investigation	300 Block of Sutherland Ave	We responded to a missing juvenile that had left home "in a fit" according to the parents. The juvenile was located hiding behind a neighbor's tree.
11-03-2020	Assist Other Agency	1300 Block of Page Rd	We assisted Metro PD with an assault call. It was determined to be a false call and the homeowner confirmed that no one had been at the residence.
11-03-2020	Suspicious Person	400 Block of West Tyne Blvd	We received a call about someone going to residences and advising them that they might lose power for a short time. It turned out to be someone working for NES and they were changing out a pole.

11-04-2020	Officer Investigation	Harding Rd & Belle Meade Blvd	We stopped a vehicle for making an illegal left hand turn. The vehicle showed up as possibly stolen out of Metro. When attempting to have the driver turn the vehicle off, he sped off. He was last seen on Harding Pl. The driver was a male subject with tattoos on the left side of his face and neck. The passenger was a female with long black hair.

It turned out to be the vehicle that was stolen that night shift attempted to stop. The vehicle was towed to the Metro Impound lot. Vehicle was located and stopped for a traffic violation. the vehicle took off and later was found unattended in a parking lot. The vehicle was not entered as stolen but it had been hotwired. The vehicle was towed by Hillwood wrecker to their lot. The vehicle was occupied by two male subjects and one female subject. It is believed that it was the same subjects that ran from night shift a couple of nights ago.
11-07-2020	Suspicious Vehicle	700 Block of Enquirer Ave	We received a call about a vehicle in the area but it was gone prior to our arrival. Since it was at shift change the day shift assisted as well.
11-07-2020	Assist Other Agency	East Brookfield & Chickering Rd	We responded to a wanted fugitives call from the FBI. The agent that called stated that the fugitives were in the area and had warrants out of other states. They were pinging their phone in this area but it was later pinged outside the city limits.

11-07-2020	Officer Investigation	Royal Oaks Pl & Iroquois Ave	Metro Nashville PD requested that we check the area for a noise complaint. Officer stopped 3 female juveniles really early in the morning and called their parents to come pick them up.
11-08-2020	LPR/Stolen Tag	Harding Rd & Lynwood Blvd	We received a LPR hit on a stolen tag. We stopped the vehicle and the registered owner was driving. We did a report to have the tag removed from the system.

11-08-2020	Suspicious Vehicle	Lynwood Blvd & Glen Eden Dr	We checked on a vehicle behind a residence and it turned out to be the owner checking on the property.
11-08-2020	Assist Citizen	Charlotte Pike & River Road	Officer responded to a drug overdose while getting gas. A homeless subject flagged the officer down and pointed out a couple in a vehicle. The driver had overdosed on Heroin and the passenger had given the driver 4 doses of their own Narcan. The officer rubbed the subject's sternum and monitored his breathing until Metro Nashville PD and EMS arrived on scene.
