Date	Incident	Address	Description
10-19-2020	Officer Investigation	Harding Rd & Belle Meade Blvd	We stopped a vehicle for speeding and the driver tried to give us a false name and date of birth. After getting his real name and date of birth, it turned out that he had a warrant out of Metro Nashville for domestic assault.
10-20-2020	Assist Citizen	4700 Block of Harding Rd	We assisted someone standing in line to vote that passed out for a bit. We called EMS and gave him some water. By the time EMS arrived, he was better and refused treatment stating that he just wanted to vote.
