- 2. Annual MS4 Report Steve Casey, P. E., stated the Annual MS4 report will be submitted to the State of Tennessee by September 30, 2020. Included in the report were 7 construction enforcement cases and 8 illicit discharge enforcement cases. Per Casey the City has been busy enforcing the Stormwater Ordinance. Permit compliance is going well.
- 3. Consideration of Bids for Snow and Ice Removal Contract On September 8, 2020 City Manager Beth Reardon and Public Works Director Larry Smith held a public bid opening for the Snow and Ice Removal Contracts. Five contractors were notified of the bid specifications, but only one bid was submitted by Sammie Gibbs Construction. This contractor has had the Snow and Ice Removal Contract with the City since 2008. The contract is for two years and requires the vendor to maintain a supply of road salt for immediate availability. Bid prices for equipment, labor and materials are on file with the City of Belle Meade Public Works Department. The bid submitted was for the same pricing as the current contract.

Reardon and Smith recommend Sammie Gibbs Construction be awarded the Snow and Ice Removal Contract.

City Manager Beth Reardon and Public Works Director Larry Smith recommend the contract be awarded to Roadrunner Sweeping. They are a new vendor for the City of Belle Meade and come highly recommended. Director Smith inspected one of the Company trucks that will be used for the work. It met the contract specifications.
