Date	Incident	Address	Description
04-06-2021	Officer Investigation	Hillsboro Rd	We located the stalking subject that also threatened and ran from us over the weekend at the YMCA in Green Hills. When they tried to arrest and handcuff him he became hostile and one of the units ended up pepper spraying him. He was booked into the jail on several warrants and more charges to come.
04-09-2021	Officer Investigation	4700 Block of Harding Rd	A female with mental illness showed up at the station. We gave her a ride to her home in Bellevue and her daughter, who was aware of her issues, met us at her home.
04-10-2021	Suspicious Vehicle	Westview Ave & Forsythe Pl	We responded to a black sedan and according to the caller it was parked for about 15 minutes with the driver inside the vehicle. The vehicle left the area prior to our arrival. The driver was described as a male subject wearing a white or yellow hat.
04-10-2021	Suspicious Person	4300 Block of Forsythe Pl.	Within the hour of the previous call we received another call about a gray sedan with a male subject in dark clothing driving. Both this subject and the subject from the earlier call showed up at a resident's door looking for an Air BnB party. The resident told the men that there was no party at this residence. The men left the area prior to our arrival.
04-11-2021	Officer Investigation	4700 Block of Harding Rd	We responded to a possibly intoxicated person. A male subject just released from St. Thomas Hospital wandered into the lobby of the police station. He refused to talk to us but did cooperate by nodding yes or no to our questions. We transported him to the address listed on his hospital paperwork.
