07-12-2021	Assist Other Agency	1200 Block of Forrest Park Dr.	Metro Nashville Police Dept. asked for assistance on a call at Cheekwood. There was an individual who was trying to steal a piece of art from one of the gardens. We made contact with the subject who advised that he wasn't going to steal the art but thought it would be funny to move it. The subject was arrested for Public Intoxication, Criminal Impersonation and Simple Possession.
07-13-2021	Traffic Stop	Harding Rd & Davidson Rd	We stopped a vehicle for speeding. When approaching the vehicle there was a strong odor of marijuana coming from it. Also found was a bottle of vodka, fake ID's and about 10 grams of marijuana. The female driver was taken to juvenile for DUI.
07-16-2021	Suspicious Person	100 Block of Belle Meade Blvd	We received a call about an uninvited guest. We located the subject leaving the property and he was in the middle of a mental health crisis and was off of his medication. We gave him a ride to Vanderbilt Hospital, where he checked in for treatment.
07-17-2021	Traffic Stop	Malone Pl & Belle Meade Blvd	We stopped a vehicle that resulted in the arrest of the driver who had warrants out of Cheatham County. The subject was taken to Criminal Justice Center to wait for Cheatham County Sheriff's Office to pick him up and the vehicle was towed.
07-18-2021	LPR/Stolen Tag	Harding Pl & Lynwood Blvd	We received a LPR hit on a stolen tag out of Washington state while we were clearing a house with the alarm going off. The vehicle gone on our arrival.
