Date	Incident	Address	Description
10-04-2021	LPR/Stolen Tag	Chickering Rd & Chickering Ln	We received a LPR hit on a stolen tag. We located the vehicle and it refused to stop. We did not pursue and issued a BOLO to Metro.
10-04-2021	Traffic Stop	Harding Pl	We made a DUI arrest. The driver was driving the wrong way down Belle Meade Blvd.
10-05-2021	LPR/Stolen Vehicle	Harding Rd & Vaughns Gap	We received a LPR hit on a stolen vehicle. Inside were three juveniles the vehicle, two of which were reported runaways. They were transported to juvenile detention for Possession of Stolen Property and Curfew Violations.
10-07-2021	Officer Investigation	100 Block of Westhampton	We received a call from Metro PD of a robbery in progress. We spoke to the residents as well as the workers at the home and everything was ok.
10-09-2021	Traffic Stop	Belle Meade Blvd & Malone Ave	We made a DUI arrest.
10-09-2021	Officer Investigation	4700 Block of Harding Rd	We assisted Metro with a call in our parking lot by making contact with the victim. Her ex had shot at her and struck her vehicle. We stayed with the victim until Metro arrived. We also helped with keeping the crime scene of her vehicle secure for their ID unit.
10-10-2021	Officer Investigation	5100 Block of Harding Rd.	We obtained a warrant on a subject who ordered food and then left without paying.
