Date	Incident	Address	Description
11-23-2021	LPR/Stolen Vehicle	Harding Rd & Jackson Blvd	We received a LPR hit on a stolen vehicle while we were at a false call in 700 block of Belle Meade Blvd, so we were unable to locate the vehicle.
11-24-2021	LPR/Stolen Vehicle	Harding Rd & Jackson Blvd	We received a LPR hit on a stolen vehicle. It came back unconfirmed through NCIC and it was gone on arrival.
11-24-2021	LPR/Stolen Vehicle	Harding Rd & Lynwood Blvd	We received another LPR hit on a stolen vehicle. The driver was the owner of the vehicle who had recovered the vehicle but failed to notify the entering agency to have it removed from NCIC.
11-25-2021	Officer Investigation	4400 Block of Harding Pl	We assisted Metro PD with a death investigation.
11-26-2021	LPR/Stolen Tag	Harding Rd & Jackson Blvd	We received a LPR hit on a stolen tag but when the dispatcher checked the tag, it came back as not stolen.
11-27-2021	Officer Investigation	100 Block of Lynwood Blvd	Metro had a rolling domestic dispute that ended in our city. The female got intoxicated for her 21 st birthday. An argument broke out in the vehicle on the way to her mother's house. She tried to get out of the vehicle while it was moving but her boyfriend stopped her. She then kicked and broke the windshield. They ran out of gas on Lynwood Blvd. Both parties denied that he had hit her. She claimed to have hit him, but he denied it. We bought him a gallon of gas and sent him to his mother's house and we gave her a ride to her mother's house.
