Date	Incident	Address	Description
02-07-2022	Officer Investigation	200 Deer Park Dr	We responded to a burglary. The unknown suspects busted the rear kitchen window to gain entry sometime from Saturday morning until Monday evening. At the time of the report it appears all that was taken was costume jewelry.
02-08-2022	Traffic Stop	5000 Block of Harding Rd	We stopped a vehicle because we did not see a license plate on the back of it. We saw a temp tag in the back window and discovered that the tag had been altered because it had expired. The driver was arrested and taken to booking.
02-10-2022	LPR/Missing Juvenile	300 Block of Jackson Blvd	We received a LPR hit on a missing juvenile. The vehicle was located and the juvenile was detained until his family came to pick him up.
02-11-2022	Officer Investigation	Belle Meade Blvd & Honeywood	We took a lost property report. A resident reported that he lost his wedding ring in a field.
02-11-2022	LPR/Missing Person	5000 Block of Harding Rd	We received a LPR hit on a missing person but it turned out that the girlfriend who was with him filed the report but didn't call to cancel the report when he returned. He has been taken out of the system now.
02-12-2022	LPR/Stolen Vehicle	Harding Rd & Lynwood Blvd	We received a LPR hit on a stolen vehicle. We located the vehicle and when we attempted to stop the vehicle it fled and we did not pursue.
02-12-2022	Traffic Stop	4500 Block of Harding Rd	We stopped a vehicle for speeding and discovered that her drivers license was suspended so a misdemeanor citation was issued.
