ORDINANCE 2021-4

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 5-109 (3) OF THE BELLE MEADE MUNICIPAL CODE TO INCREASE THE LIMITS FOR EXPENDITURES REQUIRING COMMISSION APPROVAL FROM \$1,000 TO \$3,000.

WHEREAS, the Belle Meade Municipal Code currently requires that any expenditure in excess of \$1,000 be approved by a majority vote of the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, this section of the Code has not been amended since 1989;

WHEREAS, the Board finds that this requirement is cumbersome and impractical given the increase of prices for goods and services over the past thirty (30) years;

WHEREAS, the Board finds that efficient management of its fiscal affairs warrants an increase in this purchasing limit;

NOW THEREFORE:

SECTION ONE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE that Section 5-109 (3) of the Belle Meade Municipal Code is amended to delete the words "\$1,000" and substitute therefor the words "\$3,000."

SECTION TWO: BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE, THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE CITIZENS REQUIRING IT.

ORDINANCE 2022-1

AN ORDINANCE TO CLOSE, VACATE AND ABANDON THE PEDESTRIAN WALKWAY EASEMENT AS SHOWN ON PLAT FOR THE RESUBDIVISION OF ROYAL OAKS SECTION B


WHEREAS:

- 1. There is shown on the final plat for the Resubdivision of Royal Oaks Subdivision, Section B, of record in Plat Book 1424, Page 89, Register's Office of Davidson County, Tennessee, a ten foot (10') wide pedestrian walkway extending from Lynwood Boulevard to Westview Avenue. (*See* Plat attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by reference).
- 2. The Commission hereby finds that to the extent the walkway was dedicated by plat for the benefit of the general public, it is no longer being used or maintained for that purpose, is no longer required for public use, and that the abandonment of any and all interest of the City in the pedestrian walkway is in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Belle Meade as follows:

- Section 1. The pedestrian walkway, as described above, is hereby declared closed, vacated and abandoned.
- Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon the expiration of fifteen (15) days following its adoption.
