Date	Incident	Address	Description
08-08-2022	Traffic Stop	Harding Pl & Belle Meade Blvd	We stopped a vehicle for speeding, the driver did not have a license and had a warrant from Metro PD, so we transferred him to booking.
08-09-2022	Traffic Stop	4700 Block of Harding Rd	We made a traffic stop on a vehicle for Improper Display. The driver had several outstanding warrants from Metro Pd & Trousdale County. He was also charged with drug possession and criminal content.
08-10-2022	LPR/Stolen Vehicle	4700 Block of Harding Rd	We received a LPR hit on a stolen vehicle. We were able to stop the vehicle in the parking lot of St George's. The occupants are being investigated for thefts in Rutherford County. We located several possible stolen items in the vehicle while searching it. The driver was arrested and transported to booking.
08-10-2022	LPR/Stolen Vehicle	Harding Rd & Lynwood Blvd	We received a LPR hit on a stolen vehicle. We were able to stop the vehicle and spoke to the driver/owner and discovered that the tag is on a different vehicle, not the stolen vehicle. The vehicle that was reported stolen was repossessed and the owner did not notify Metro.
08-11-2022	LPR/Stolen Tag	Harding Rd & Belle Meade Blvd	We received a LPR hit on a stolen tag. We were unable to locate the vehicle.
08-12-2022	Traffic Stop	Lynwood Blvd & Iroquois Ave	We made a traffic stop and the driver was cited and arrested for Driving on a Revoked License.
08-12-2022	Traffic Stop	Iroquois Ave & Belle Meade Blvd	We made a traffic stop and discovered that the tag had been suspended for not having insurance, so it was seized and will be sent back to the state.
08-13-2022	Assist Citizen	Percy Warner Park	We assisted Nashville Fire Dept, EMS and Metro Police Dept. with a female, who has a history of heart trouble, that was found not breathing and unresponsive on one of the trails. She was transported to the hospital.
