Date	Incident	Address	Description
07-25-2022	Traffic Stop	1300 Block of Chickering Rd	We stopped a vehicle for speeding and discovered the driver was wanted for leaving the scene of an accident in Jackson County. He was transported to Davidson County jail to wait for Jackson County to pick him up.
07-26-2022	LPR/Stolen Vehicle	Highway 100 & Vaughn's Gap	We received a LPR hit on a stolen vehicle. We were able to stop the vehicle and arrest the driver and had the vehicle was towed.
07-27-2022	LPR/Stolen Tag	Lynwood Blvd & Glen Eden	We received a LPR hit on a stolen tag. We got a second hit on Harding Rd & Lynwood Blvd on the same vehicle. Both times we were not able to locate the vehicle.
07-29-2022	LPR/Stolen Vehicle	Harding Pl & Lynwood Blvd	We received a LPR hit on a stolen vehicle. It also hit again on Harding Rd. and Jackson Blvd but we were not able locate the vehicle on either site.
07-29-2022	Officer Investigation	400 Block of Lynwood Blvd	We took a report of a possible burglary. We cleared the house and Detective Sexton was notified.
07-30-2022	LPR/Stolen Vehicle	Harding Rd & Lynwood Blvd	We received a LPR hit on a stolen vehicle. We were able to locate the vehicle at Harding Rd & Harding Pl. The vehicle fled at a high rate of speed, so we did not pursue.
07-30-2022	Officer Investigation	Post Rd & Davidson Rd	We attempted a traffic stop on a vehicle that fled and we did not pursue it. We spotted it again and it fled up Leake Ave. We found the vehicle in the 600 block of Enquirer but the driver was not with the vehicle. While searching the area, another vehicle slowly drove by so we stopped that vehicle and discovered that the driver that fled was the passenger so we placed her under arrest.
