Date	Incident	Address	Description
10-03-2022	LPR/Missing Person	Harding Rd & Davidson Rd	We received a LPR hit on a missing person. We stopped the vehicle and it was not the missing person driving but the driver did advise where the missing person might be. He advised that the missing person had let him borrow his vehicle.
10-03-2022	Traffic Stop	Harding Rd & Clarendon Ave	We stopped a vehicle for speeding. After checking the driver's license, we discovered that the license was suspended and he had warrants out of Georgia but they would not extradite. The driver was issued a misdemeanor citation.
10-04-2022	Traffic Stop	Harding Rd & Davidson Rd	We stopped a vehicle for improper display of tag. After checking the driver's license we discovered that the license was revoked. The driver was issued a misdemeanor citation.

The officer smelled alcohol on the drivers' breath and she admitted to drinking wine and taking pills. Driver was taken to General Hospital for a panic attack. After being cleared from the hospital, the driver was taken to booking for charges of DUI, Evading Arrest, and Resisting Arrest.
10-09-2022	Officer Investigation	200 Block of Lynwood Blvd	We took a report of stolen money, purses and jewelry during an open house.
