Date	Incident	Address	Description
09-19-2022	Officer Investigation	4700 Block of Harding Rd	We took a report in reference to a license plate lost in the mail.
09-19-2022	Traffic Stop	4500 Block of Harding Rd	We stopped a vehicle for speeding. When we checked the driver we discovered he had a warrant in Sumner County. The driver was transported to booking to be picked up by them.
09-20-2022	Officer Investigation	600 Block of Lynwood Blvd	We took a report of theft of tools from a van parked at a construction site.
09-23-2022	LPR/Wanted Person	Harding Pl & Enquirer Ave.	We received a LPR hit on a wanted person. We were not able to locate the vehicle he was in.
09-23-2022	Officer Investigation	Page Rd	We found 3 juveniles walking on Page Rd. around 3am. They were at a sleep over but decided to leave for a while. Two of them were taken home and the third was picked up by a parent. We also went by the home of the sleep over to advise the parents of the situation.
09-24-2022	LPR/Stolen Vehicle	Harding Rd & Jackson Blvd	We responded to a LPR hit on a stolen vehicle. We spotted the vehicle and attempted to stop it and it struck the police cruiser. We terminated the pursuit, but the stolen vehicle struck 2 vehicles. Two male subjects fled the scene on foot. We were able to find one of them and take him into custody.
09-24-2022	Officer Investigation	Deer Park Dr	We were able to apprehend the second subject from the incident above with the assistance of Metro K-9. The subject was taken to the hospital with a dog bite, then released and taken to booking. Both subjects were charged with multiple felony and misdemeanors. Also, no one was hurt when the stolen vehicle struck the two vehicles or the police cruiser.
