Date	Incident	Address	Description
12-13-2022	Traffic Stop	Harding Rd & Richland Creek	We stopped a vehicle for improper passing. When we ran the drivers license of the driver, we discovered that the license was suspended, so the driver was issued a Misdemeanor citation.
12-14-2022	LPR/Stolen Vehicle	Harding Rd & Jackson Blvd	We received a LPR hit on a stolen vehicle. We stopped the vehicle and the registered owner was driving the vehicle. It appeared that Metro Nashville PD failed to remove it from the system.
12-14-2022	Officer Investigation	Harding Rd & Leake Ave.	We had a hit and run accident and the report was completed.
12-15-2022	Officer Investigation	Harding Rd & Leake Ave	The detective was able to identify the suspect from the hit and run. The driver was cited into city court and Davidson County General Sessions.
12-16-2022	LPR/Stolen Vehicle	Lynwood Blvd & Tyne Blvd	We received a LPR hit on a stolen vehicle and again the same vehicle at Harding Pl and Enquirer Ave. On both occasions the vehicle was gone prior to our arrival.
12-16-2022	Traffic Stop	Harding Rd & Jackson Blvd	We made an arrest for Drug Possession after stopping a vehicle for speeding.
12-17-2022	LPR/Stolen Vehicle	Harding Pl & Enquirer Ave	We received a LPR hit on the same vehicle from 12/16/22 at the same locations. Again, it was gone prior to our arrival.
12-17-2022	LPR/Stolen Tag	Harding Rd & Lynwood Blvd	We received a LPR hit on a stolen tag but it was gone prior to our arrival.
12-17-2022	LPR/Stolen Vehicle	Tyne Blvd & Lynwood Blvd	We received a LPR hit on the same vehicle from the past 2 days. We were finally able to stop it and discovered the driver was the owner and had recovered his vehicle.
