Date	Incident	Address	Description
02-20-2023	LPR/Runaway Juvenile	Harding Rd & Lynwood Blvd	We received a LPR hit on a vehicle that a runaway was suppose to be in. When we pulled the car over and the juvenile's father was driving and he stated that his son was home with an ankle monitor. We notified the agency that had entered the tag and juvenile so they could remove it from the system.
02-20-2023	Traffic Stop	4400 Block of Harding Rd	We stopped a vehicle for Improper Display of tags and discovered the driver was Driving on a Revoked License.
02-21-2023	LPR/Stolen Tag	Harding Rd & Lynwood Blvd	We received a LPR hit on a stolen tag. We stopped the vehicle and discovered that the driver of the vehicle was the owner of the vehicle and the tag had been recovered back in November.
02-21-2023	LPR/Stolen Tag/Vehicle	Lynwood Lane	We received a LPR hit on a stolen vehicle and tag. When we tried to stop the vehicle it attempted to drive through yards to escape but the vehicle became inoperable and both subjects in the vehicle were taken into custody. The passenger, a pregnant juvenile was taken to Vanderbilt Hospital and later released to her mother later that day.
02-22-2023	Officer Investigation	4300 Block of Sunnybrook Dr	We responded in reference to a juvenile having a medical issue. He was transported to Vanderbilt Children's Hospital.
02-24-2023	LPR/Stolen Vehicle	Harding Place & Lynwood Blvd	We received a LPR hit on a stolen vehicle. We were able to stop the vehicle and arrest the driver.
02-25-2023	Traffic Stop	Westview Ave & Iroquois Ave	We stopped a vehicle for failing to stop at a stop sign. The driver was issued a misdemeanor citation for Driving on a Suspended License & Simple Possession of Drugs.
