RAAJEL, Nashville, home of Mr. and Mrs. Rufus E. Fort, Jr., is built on part of the old deer park belonging to the historic estate "Belle Meade." It combines the advantages given by a location of natural beauty and careful artistic planning. This Colonial adaption home is built on the bluff overlooking Richland Creek. The entrance avenue of elms leads directly into the forecourt which serves as a background for massed shrubbery against which white tulips and candytuft grow. Boxwood and magnolias frame the entrance which is centered by a reflecting pool of night and day blooming water lilies.
