RESOLUTION 2023-06

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A SPEED LIMIT OF TWENTY-FIVE (25) MILES PER HOUR ON ENQUIRER AVENUE AND GERALD PLACE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority of Section 15-301 of the Belle Meade Municipal Code, it is unlawful to operate any motor vehicle other than a truck within the city limits at a rate of speed in excess of thirty (30) miles per hour, except that the Board of Commissioners may authorize by resolution the posting of signs with other speed limits, in which case such speed limits shall apply;

WHEREAS, the Board finds that a speed limit of twenty-five (25) miles per hour on Enquirer Avenue and on Gerald Place is warranted in light of characteristics and conditions of those streets and would be in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of those streets and the City generally;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Signs are to be posted on Enquirer Avenue and Gerald Place indicating that the speed limits on those streets shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour and those speed limits shall be enforced pursuant to Section 15-301 of the Belle Meade Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon the posting of the said speed limit signs, the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the of City of Belle Meade, Tennessee requiring it.
