Date	Incident	Address	Description
10-08-2024	Assist Other Agency	Glen Eden Dr & Jackson Blvd	We assisted the Nashville Fire Department with a vehicle fire. The driver was able to get out of the vehicle without any injuries and after a few hours, the vehicle was towed and the area was opened back up to traffic.
10-08-2024	LPR/Stolen Tag	Harding Rd & Lynwood Blvd.	We responded to a LPR hit on a stolen tag. We were unable to locate the vehicle.
10-08-2024	Assist Other Agency	800 Block of Belle Meade Blvd.	We assisted Metro Fire Department with a medical call. The individual was evaluated and denied further assistance after finding out it was due to low blood sugar.
10-10-2024	Officer Investigation	4300 Block of Warner Pl	We received another call about the political sign being taken again. Again, we were able to gather footage from the cameras and caught the suspects in the act. The case was again turned over to Detective Sexton, who was able to identify the vehicle and driver. He made contact and the sign was returned the next day.
10-11-2024	Officer Investigation	500 Block of Leake Ave.	We received a call about a male subject in the park with kids and he to be intoxicated. We had him call his mother to pick him and the kids up and his father retrieved his vehicle a little while later.
10-12-2024	Assist Citizen	Harding Rd. & Davidson Rd	We responded to a call about someone sitting on the side of the road. We made contact with the subject, who advised that she was not feeling well. We called for an ambulance and she was transported to St. Thomas West.
